Renée Fleming is one of the most highly acclaimed singers of our time. Winner of four Grammy® awards, and recipient of the US National Medal of Arts, she has sung for momentous occasions from the Nobel Peace Prize ceremony to the Diamond Jubilee Concert for Queen Elizabeth II at Buckingham Palace. In 2014, Renée brought her voice to a vast new audience as the first classical artist ever to sing the National Anthem at the Super Bowl.

Vocalists must submit an unedited video recording of themselves performing two complete arias with piano accompaniment.


The work(s) must be composed for soloist and symphony or string orchestra, in original key and/or language (unless changed by concert tradition).

Applicants selected to audition in person on January 29, 2022 will be notified by January 17, 2022.

The winner of the Young Artists Competition will earn a \$1,000 scholarship and perform with the Lakeland Symphony Orchestra on March 5, 2022.

Ludwig von Beethoven was born in Bonn, Germany in December 1770, so his 250th birthday was celebrated in 2020.

Although he began to lose his hearing around age 26, Beethoven composed six symphonies in addition to piano concertos, string quartets and more between 1806 and his death in 1827.






BRANSCOMB AUDITORIUM
